SVHS Students! Sign up now to participate in the Fashion Show!

Hit the runway in our sixth annual Fashion Show Fundraising Event. Our students, as well as the merchandise modeled, are the stars of this exciting event! We need your participation to be successful.

We will be accepting 100 contracts for 2016. All Seniors are automatically eligible to model in the shows. Juniors, Sophomores and Freshmen may enter the lottery for a chance to model. All students, including seniors, must complete the Participation Contract and return it to the school library or by mail to address at end of document. All decisions made by the Fashion Show committee are final. Completion of a contract does not guarantee your participation. A list of accepted models will be posted on the Office door and on the Fashion Show Facebook page by January 25, 2016. Please read carefully as there are changes. **The contract must be signed by the student and parent and returned by January 22, 2016.**

Please complete a Model Participation Contract if you are able to commit to the following requirements:

1. Models must participate in BOTH Luncheon and Dinner Shows on March 12, 2016.
2. Models must be fitted for clothing at local merchant's place of business. Dates and times will be arranged by volunteer parents/store coordinators.
3. Models MUST attend all rehearsals. **FAILURE TO ATTEND ALL ASSIGNED REHEARSALS MAY RESULT IN A MODEL BEING DROPPED FROM THE SHOW.** Rehearsal dates: Rehearsal dates are: TO BE DETERMINED. Final Rehearsal date is Friday March 11 at Marin Country Club. Notify of time later.
4. Models must treat the loaned clothing with care. All articles must be returned to the proper hangers, with original packaging and kept organized so that nothing is misplaced. Ladies should take care that make-up is not transferred to the clothing. No perfume, cologne or aftershave is allowed to be worn while wearing the clothes and models must wear clear “no show” antiperspirant/deodorant. Tags must not be removed from garments. Please remember that these items have been loaned and must be returned in saleable condition.
5. All school rules and behavior, as outlined in the SVHS Parent/Student Handbook will apply and will be strictly enforced; (i.e. language, behavior, illegal substances, etc). This applies to rehearsals, on and off campus, fittings at merchant locations and the shows. Proper conduct is a must. Please be advised your parents will be notified to remove you from the premises if you are found to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol during rehearsals or day of show.
6. Models will wear the clothing that the merchants have chosen to lend. Models may not request substitutions and may not contact store managers or owners. Lost or damaged clothing is the responsibility of the model and replacement costs will be the model's responsibility. The success of this and future shows depends upon the continued generosity of many area retailers. Students are not allowed to eat food, chew gum and ONLY allowed to drink water during rehearsals or show at Marin Country Club.
7. Failure to comply with any portion of the contract may result in termination of participation in the Fashion Show.
8. Student participants will earn 10 Service Hours if all commitments are completed. A list of students earning Service Hours will be kept by the committee and turned in to the school. No essay will be required for these service hours.

*Please remember that how you conduct yourselves during rehearsals, fittings and the shows themselves has a huge impact on the success of this event and future Fashion Shows as well. We rely on and are very grateful for the generosity of the merchants that support us in this event. If, for any reason, they have a poor experience, they will not support us in the future. **All profits from this event benefit St. Vincent High School. Keep this page for reference. This contract must be signed by student AND parent and returned to the School Library by Jan. 22, or given to Megan Dunn (senior) who will give it to production chair Katie Dunn.***

- I will attend **ALL REHEARSALS**. Rehearsal dates are: TO BE DETERMINED.
Final rehearsal: Friday, March 11 at Marin Country Club. **Please mark your calendar with these dates NOW.**
Failure to attend the assigned rehearsals may result in model being dropped from the show.
- I agree to perform in both the Luncheon and Dinner Shows on Saturday, March 12, 2016.
- I will attend the scheduled fittings for my assigned merchant(s) and agree to model the clothing that the merchant has chosen without requesting substitutions.
- I will treat all loaned clothing with care, returning all items to the designated hangers or packaging after each show. I understand that I am responsible for the replacement costs of any lost or damaged clothing.
- I will not eat food or chew gum while in garments and will **ONLY** drink water during rehearsals or day/night of show.
- I will fully cooperate with all volunteers and coordinators for this event, including Store Parents, Choreographers, adults on site at the shows, etc.
- I understand that I am representing St. Vincent High School in all aspects of this project and will conduct myself accordingly. I understand that all school behavior rules, as outlined in the Parent/Student Handbook, apply and will be strictly enforced on and off campus for this event. I realize that student behavior affects the future of this event.
